These students will be awarded first through sixth place in “Inspected and Sealed” and “Price Verification” categories at an awards ceremony at the Medina County Career Center Cafe, February 5.

Kyra Papp, William Schaeffer, Cole McCurley and Matthew Harvey of the Medina County Career Center and Kiersten White and Tyler Leatherman of Wadsworth High School are in the top six finalists for the “Inspected and Sealed” category.

Josephine Earls, Calvin Reverente, Emily States and Abigail Bechen of the Medina County Career Center, Nathan Dietrich of Wadsworth High School and Tori Rogers of Black River High School are in the top six finalists for the “Price Verification” category.

Over 250 high school students turned in seals design entries. The designs of all the finalists will be featured on measuring devices throughout the county.

“Medina County is fortunate to have extremely talented students,” said Kovack. “We look forward to recognizing them and awarding their places and prizes in February.”

The Weights and Measures program, overseen by Kovack, is a state-mandated program to ensure that all devices are working properly in the county and to ensure consumers can buy with confidence.
