Auditor Kovack Awards Brunswick Citizenship Scholarship

Mike Kovack, Medina County Auditor, recently announced that Macey Mullins is the winner of the annual Auditor Kovack Citizenship Scholarship. Mullins is a graduating senior at Brunswick High School and received a \$500 award.

Mullins plans to attend the University of Tampa where she will major in psychology. Not only will she graduate from high school with an Associate's degree from Cuyahoga Community College through the College Credit Plus program, she will also graduate Summa Cum Laude. She has served as vice president of the Gender, Sexuality Alliance; team captain of the Environment Club and provided psychology research for the 2018 Conference on Confronting Poverty. She is a volunteer mathematics tutor and volunteer youth volleyball coach, all while working in customer service at Mapleside Farms.

The \$500 scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating Brunswick High School senior who has a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, resides in the Brunswick City School District and plans on attending a two or four-year degree program from an accredited community, state or private college or university.
