Auditor's Data Collectors Back in the Community

Michael E. Kovack, Medina County Auditor, announced today that his staff of data collectors will be back out in the county starting on Monday, November 9, 2009.

Data collectors' sole responsibility is to collect and update information on a continuous basis for both commercial and residential properties. At this time, they will largely be looking at new constructions for updates on their progress.

It is important for the general public to know that all the data collectors in the Auditor's Office must wear identification badges and clothing clearly marked "Medina County Auditor's Office." Their vehicles will also be marked appropriately. Before collecting information about a property, it is the responsibility of the data collector to make his or her presence known to the homeowner, if construction has been completed. No data collector should enter anyone's home except in an instance where an appointment has been made and, in that case, will be accompanied by another data collector."
