

22nd Annual Medina County Auditor Seals Design Contest

This contest is for high school-level students living in Medina County, including homeschoolers and those who attend school outside the county.

NEW THIS YEAR: Adult category! For adults 18 and over (out of high school).

The top 6 seals in each high school division and the top 2 seals in the adult division will be displayed county-wide.

TOP DESIGNS WIN EITHER A \$75 CASH PRIZE OR A \$50 RESTAURANT GIFT CARD

Guidelines for Submission

WHAT TO INCLUDE ON YOUR DESIGN:

- ▶ Must be 2.75" in any direction of a circle, square or other shape.
- ▶ There are two categories of seal designs:
 1. **Inspected and Sealed** and 2. **Passed Price Verification**.You may enter in one or both categories.
- ▶ The following **FIVE ITEMS** must appear on **ALL SEAL DESIGNS**:
 1. The name **MIKE KOVACK** should be in capital letters and prominently displayed in an easy-to-read font.
 2. The words **Medina County Auditor** in either all caps or upper and lower case.
 3. The year of inspection - **2022-2023** - must appear.
 4. The Auditor's office website: **www.medinacountyauditor.org**
 5. The Auditor's phone numbers with the area code. The number should read: **(330) 725-9764**. The toll-free number should also be listed: **(844) 722-3800**.
- ▶ For the **Inspected and Sealed** category, the sticker must say "Inspected and Sealed" and be easy to read.
- ▶ For the **Passed Price Verification** category, the sticker must say "Passed Price Verification" and "Equity in the Market Place" and be easy to read.
- ▶ Colors and artwork are left to your imagination. Make sure images are high resolution. The seal will be publicly displayed and therefore must be easily readable - this is a prime consideration for judging.
- ▶ Winners can expect to see their stickers displayed in 2022 on Medina County commercial devices inspected by the Auditor's Office.
- ▶ The designer's name must appear on the sticker in an inconspicuous, but readable manner.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ARTWORK

The entry should be emailed to: **spappas@medinaco.org**. Adobe Illustrator format is preferred, saved as an EPS or PDF. We recommend keeping the images to 6MB or less. **We will not accept scanned images or JPEGs.**

Along with the entry, list the following:

For Students: Student Name, Student Email, Grade, Student Phone Number, Parent Phone Number, Parent Email, Name of High School (or home-schooled), Name of Teacher if the design is part of a class project.

For Adults: Name, Email, Address and Phone Number

Proofread carefully. Omissions, misspellings and errors reduce the chances of winning.
